The Trinity - the True and Living God

When many people think of the Trinity, they think of Gods Trinitarian existence in heaven, but they fail to think of the Trinity as having any practical relevance to our knowledge of God on earth. The truth is that apart from the Trinity, there is no knowledge of God on earth; there is only second hand knowledge about God at best and many false ideas invented by human speculation. It is through Trinitarian revelation that we encounter the true and living God. We know of God as He is making Himself known.

Apart from Trinitarian revelation, there is only one human telling another about God - no first hand experience of God. Many people who say they believe in God, believe in what they have heard about God, not in God who they know of through their own experience of Trinitarian revelation. It is our job in the church to help people to move beyond hearing about God to encountering the God who reveals Himself. Now, let us look specifically at Trinitarian revelation and how we can know God through this revelation.

- 1. God the Father God exists as other than His creation as the creator of all that exists. God the Father reveals to us Gods transcendence He is beyond the universe and therefore not a thing among other things. God is a unique and transcendent Being who is mysterious and hidden from human knowledge. God the Father reveals Himself to us through His special acts of revelation, which are recorded in the Old Testament and most especially through His son, Jesus Christ. God the Father, God above and beyond us, breaks into history and into our lives.
- 2. God the Son is God alongside of us: God Himself walking and talking with us in the person of Jesus. In Jesus, God exists objectively in our world. God as Father transcends our world, but in Jesus, this transcendent God is objective, tangible, and knowable. Jesus is God among us and it is through Jesus that we know of God the Father. Jesus is the ultimate revelation of the Father.
- 3. The Holy Spirit is the subjective revelation of the Father and the Son. The Holy Spirit is God working inside of us, stirring our hearts, illuminating our minds and making us aware of Gods presence inside of us. The Holy Spirit in us brings Jesus and His Father into us. It is through the Holy Spirit that we encounter the objective revelation of Jesus and the Transcendent revelation of the Father. When a person trusts Jesus, coming to Jesus with the faith and repentance, a miracle happens: the Holy Spirit brings Jesus inside of them filling them with the transforming Grace of Jesus Christ and they are born again. The Holy Spirits working inside of us connects us with Jesus, so that we can experience personal knowledge, relationship and transformation through Jesus. God wants us to encounter Himself through His Trinitarian revelation, so that we can meet the true and living God rather than merely hear about human ideas about God. God wants us to open our souls to let in His Holy Spirit, not just believe in God as an interesting idea. Trinitarian Revelation brings God inside us through the subjective work of the Spirit, which in turn, brings to us the objective revelation of the Son, and the objective Revelation of the Son brings us the Transcendent Revelation of the Father.

The Trinity is not an esoteric doctrine dreamed up by theologians to confuse lay people. The Trinity is the true and living God revealing Himself to us and in so doing, transforming us. **Do not accept anything less than a life-changing encounter with the Trinitarian God.**


